Bridgemark Dress Code

Uniforms will be worn daily unless a special day is approved.

Boys: khaki, navy or black slacks or **knee-length shorts (no cargo or athletic shorts)** with any color plain-front, polo-style shirt (short-sleeved or long-sleeved); shirts tucked in with a belt (student choice); Bridgemark sweatshirt or fleece jacket; navy, black or white leggings or long sleeve shirts underneath uniform during cold weather

Girls: khaki, navy, or black slacks, **knee-length shorts**, skirts, skorts, uniform dresses, or jumpers with any color plain-front, polo-style shirt (short-sleeved or long-sleeved); shirts tucked in with a belt (student choice); Bridgemark sweatshirt or fleece jacket; navy, black or white cardigan; navy, black or white leggings or long sleeve shirts underneath uniform during cold weather

Jeans days: appropriate blue jean pants or shorts (no holes, patches, etc.) with an approved Bridgemark t-shirt. Turquoise Bridgemark shirt will be worn on Wednesday and any Bridgemark spirit shirt may be worn on Friday.

Casual dress days: Clothes must be neat and clean – not torn, fringed, excessively tight, form fitting, or excessively loose, and should be of a modest design or style. This means no tank tops, spaghetti straps, low revealing tops, short shorts (clothes should be no shorter than 4 inches above the top of the knee), mini skirts (even with tights under), no inappropriate t-shirt logos, skulls etc....

- * All students should come to Bridgemark prepared to participate in P.E.
- * Hair for girls and boys must be clean and neatly groomed and may not include noticeable unnatural coloring or bizarre styling. Boys should keep their hair above their collar and out of their eyes.
- * Athletic shoes must be worn at all times.
- * Tattoos of any kind, whether permanent or temporary, are not permitted.
- * Girls: Make up and jewelry must be modest. Girls may wear one pair of earrings and no other piercing is allowed.
- * Boys: No piercings, make up, nail polish, or hats.

Bridgemark staff retains the authority to determine the appropriateness of a student's attire and may remove a student from classes. A student in violation of the dress code will be required to correct the problem at that time. Parents may be called to bring appropriate clothes. A student that exhibits a continued disregard for the Bridgemark dress code will be recommended for a three-day suspension.
